We began oyster farming in 1983 with the goal of raising high quality, sustainable shellfish in a beautiful location. Today, we raise all five edible oyster varieties found in the Northern Hemisphere and Manila clams, make hand-finished mineral sea salt, and harvest seaweed from our oyster equipment. It's all part of our commitment to harvest and grow foods that are good for people, our local communities, and our coastal environment—and that taste great, too.

THE WHOLE HOG EXPERIENCE

Immerse yourself in oyster farming with a tour, tasting, and master class in shucking. Explore our farm and learn how oysters are grown and farmed, the marine environment, and how we use sustainable aquaculture techniques to raise our shellfish. Learn to shuck oysters like a pro, take a deep dive into oyster tasting, and enjoy a light chef's tasting at our outdoor cafe, The Boat Oyster Bar.

Located at the historic Bergfeld Vineyard at the base of the Mayacama Mountains, HALL St. Helena is a vibrant, 33-acre property off Highway 29 in the charming town of St. Helena. Guests arrive with an official welcome from (not so little) Bunny Foo-Foo and instantly experience a one-of-a-kind destination. Blind Tasting Experience - Learn about wine, tasting, and compete against friends or co-workers with our fun education, and team-building wine tasting. The first team to correctly identify all four wines is the winner. After the winner is chosen, the wine educator will reveal the wines and discuss each wine's history, style, and expression of place.









Oakville Winery - Production Tour & Barrel Tasting

Nestled within the historic Napa Wine Company, right next to the iconic Oakville Grocery, our tasting room offers an intimate and welcoming space to savor our family's estate-grown wines. Featuring Ghost Block, Oakville Winery, and Elizabeth Rose, each wine reflects our deep-rooted commitment to farming and winemaking, capturing the essence of Napa Valley. Grgich Hills Estate - Retrospective Tasting & Paired Lunch

Miljenko "Mike" Grgich first gained international recognition at the celebrated "Paris Tasting" of 1976. Then, in a now-historic blind tasting, a panel of eminent French judges swirled, sniffed, and sipped an array of the fabled white Burgundies of France and a small sampling of upstart Chardonnays from the Napa Valley. When their scores were tallied, the French judges were shocked: they had chosen the 1973 Chateau Montelena Chardonnay, crafted by Mike Grgich, as the finest white wine in the world. Mon Dieu! After his victory in Paris, Mike sat down with Austin Hills and his sister, Mary Lee Strebl, from the Hills Bros. Coffee family, and on Independence Day 1977, they gave birth to Grgich Hills. It was an ideal partnership.



Castello di Amorosa - Castle Tour & Tasting

Castello di Amorosa is a winery located near Castello di Amorosa is a winery located near Calistoga, California. The winery opened to the public in April 2007, as the project of a fourth-generation vintner, Dario Sattui, who also owns and operates the V. Sattui Winery named after his great-grandfather, Vittorio Sattui, who originally established a winery in San Francisco in 1885 after emigrating from Italy to California. The castle interiors, which include 107 rooms on 8 levels above and below ground, were approximately 121,000 square feet Among many other features, it includes a moat; a drawbridge, defensive towers, an interior courtyard, a torture chamber, a chapel/church, a knights' chamber, and a great hall with a 22-foot high coffered ceiling. The gem of our guided tours! This intimate, adults-only experience offers a unique look at the Castello.



Sterling Vineyards - Gondola Ride and Paired Lunch

Long-time friends and colleagues, Michael Stone and Peter Newton, had a lot of passions in common. At the top of their list were: wine, business, vacationing in the Greek Islands, and Northern California. In 1964, Sterling Vineyards was born. As one of only 27 bonded wineries in Napa Valley at the time, Sterling Vineyards' Bordeauxinspired wines helped transform the region into the premier winemaking appellation it is today. In 1969, the winery bottled the first vintage-dated Napa Valley Merlot and made its first vintages of Cabernet Sauvignon and Sauvignon Blanc. Enjoy breathtaking views as you ascend to the winery via an aerial gondola. Upon arrival at the top of the hill, you will join your hosts in their Hilltop Tasting Room which overlooks the Napa Valley for a memorable seated tasting experience. During the experience, you'll be guided through a tasting selection of five winery exclusive wines paired with lunch with a beautiful view of the valley.



Raymond Vineyards - Winemaker For a Day



Arriving to Napa in 1933, the Raymond family became deeply connected to the valley's winemaking origins. In 1970, Rutherford that now comprises 300 acres in Rutherford, St. Helena, and Jameson Canyon. Five generations of the Raymond family created a Napa icon, with an enduring reputation for elegant wines with a beautiful balance of finesse, power, and complexity. The Winemaker for a Day experience at Raymond Vineyards lets guests blend, bottle, and label their own wine, creating a unique, personalized vintage.

The story of Dry Creek Vineyard and the Stare Wallace family isn't one of fairy tales. Their story is this: one dedicated family working day and night for five decades to turn what many considered an idealistic pipedream, into a reality that revolutionized the California wine industry. Today Dry Creek Vineyard is one of the last truly private, family-owned, iconic wineries consistently producing 90+ point wines. Let's see how engaged your pallet is when you, as a team, compete against other Kuper Wine Club members in identifying varietals by using all your senses

and tasting your way through five different varietals, all







planted on the Dry Creek Vineyards estate.

For nearly a century, the Pedroncelli family has been crafting exceptional wines in Sonoma County's Dry Creek Valley. It all began in 1927 when John Pedroncelli, Sr. purchased a vineyard and a small winery west of Geyserville; two elements have remained unchanged since then - the exceptional place the Pedroncelli family farms their vineyards and their dedication to creating fine wines. This is always something Julie and I have wanted to put together as part of one of our trips and we've finally been able to make it happen. Enjoy the Pedroncelli vineyard and winey as we will have the entire property to ourselves for a tour, tasting, and dinner at the most perfect time to be in a vineyard: Golden Hour.







Balletto Vineyards - Baseball Field Experience & Tasting

Founder and owner John Balletto started the business after the untimely death of his father in 1977. At the age of 17, he put his family's needs before his own and relinquished several college athletic scholarship offers so he could stay home and help his mother, Hazel, run the small five-acre farm. After seeing the high-quality Russian River Valley wines crafted from their fruit by other wine producers, John and Terri decided to pursue winemaking under the "Balletto Vineyards" name. They saved one-tenth of the fruit for themselves, selecting the top 10 percent of quality, and in 2001 created the first vintage of Balletto Vineyards estate wines from Russian River Valley. In addition to making world-class wine in the Russian River Valley, the Balletto family also loves baseball and so created a "field of dreams" of sorts – a full-sized baseball field right in the middle of the vineyard. You will be able to run the bases, hit a pop fly, and play catch, all while enjoying the amazing wine John and his team create at Balletto.



Martinelli Vineyards - Vinyard Tour, Tasting & Lunch

The Martinelli family has grown grapes in the Russian River Valley since the 1880s, when teenage newlyweds Giuseppe Martinelli and Luisa Vellutini emigrated from Tuscany to California. Giuseppe, a trained winemaker, was hired to plant vines in Forestville and soon purchased his own land with Luisa. Together they planted Zinfandel and Muscat Alexandria on what became the legendary Jackass Hill—still the steepest non-terraced vineyard in Sonoma County after 135 years. Enjoy a guided tour of the historic vines and winery, followed by a locally sourced lunch paired with a curated selection of Martinelli wines.



Flanagan Vineyard - Vineyard Tour & Tasting

Founded from a passion for wine and a fascination with how soil and climate influence grape expression, Flanagan Wines began in 1999 with the planting of its first vineyard on Bennett Mountain. After years of exploring global wine regions and studying terroir, the founder expanded operations in 2016 by acquiring a premier site near Healdsburg, redeveloping the vineyards, and relocating production. Today, Flanagan Wines crafts exceptional wines from some of Sonoma County's most acclaimed vineyards and is recognized for its dedication to site-driven winemaking. Stroll through the vines and learn directly from the team behind the wine. Discover how viticulture decisions shape the final product, ask questions, and enjoy wines from both Flanagan and Riley's Rows. The tour concludes with a guided tasting of estate-produced wines.



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Quivira Vineyards - Scavenger Hunt, Tasting & Paired Lunch

Founded in 1981 by Holly and Henry Wendt, Quivira reflects a deep appreciation for the natural beauty and winemaking tradition of Dry Creek Valley. Since 2006, Pete and Terri Kight have continued the legacy, with a strong focus on organic farming and sustainability. The estate is home to Wine Creek, a restored habitat for Coho salmon and Steelhead trout, as well as a 150-year-old fig tree—symbols of Quivira's thriving ecosystem. Explore Quivira on a fun estate scavenger hunt highlighting their unique farming and winemaking practices. Enjoy a delicious lunch paired with a flight of exceptional Quivira wines.
